LEVEL TWO

Note: The candidate must have completed NZMSM Grade Three Theory of Music.

TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Comprehensive Book of Scales and Arpeggios Magic on Piano, Book 2

All technical work must be expressively played, from memory. **Scales:** mm 184

Major Scales of F and G Two octaves, similar motion, ascending and descending, hands together. Legato and staccato. Final note is held for one beat.

Major Scales of D and Bb Harmonic Minor Scales of A and E Two octaves, ascending and descending, separate hands.

Major Scales of C and G Two octaves, **contrary motion**, hands together. Legato and staccato. Final note is held for one beat.

Arpeggios: mm 80

D, A and Bb Major A and E Minor Two octaves, ascending and descending, separate hands.

Inversions: mm | 80

C, G, D, F, A and Bb Major

A and E Minor One octave of root, first inversion, second inversion. Ascending only, separate hands.

Must be played as crotchet beats.

Magic On Piano: mm . 84

Book 2, Exercise No. 20

Also transpose into the keys of G and F.

STUDY: 15 marks

Book 2, Exercises No. 14, 17, 22 and 23

- > Arrange and perform from memory, a selection of twelve bars from the exercises listed above.
- Above each bar, state the exercise and bar number being used, e.g. 14/2.
- No more than two consecutive bars from any one exercise should be used at a time.
- Expression marks **must** be included and marked on the music.
- The bars **must** be renumbered.
- > The final study **must** be either computer written or hand written **by the candidate**.
- > The candidate's name, area and level **must** be written at the top of the page.
- A copy of the study must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations, as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

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SIGHT READING: 15 marks

- > To play an eight bar passage. In 3/4 time.
- > Time values include dotted minims, minims and crotchets.
- ➢ In the keys of C, G or F.
- The candidate may practice any two bars once only prior to starting.

PIECES: 30 marks for each piece

Three pieces must be performed, one piece from each section.

Additional expression signs and dynamics may be added and marked on the music.

The candidate's name, age (if under 13 years), level and area must be written at the top of each page.

A copy of each piece must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations, as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

- Embellishments and harmony **may** be used.
- > Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.
- The bass line **must** be played from memory. An example of the bass pattern/s used **must** be noted on the music.
- The bars **must** be numbered.
- > Expression and dynamics **must** be included and marked on the music.

No repeats except D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

Viva Voce: 10 marks

- > General questions will be asked about the piece performed for this section including:
 - the type and style of music
 - the country of origin
 - the composer

OR

Section C2: 30 marks

Own Composition

Criteria for this section:

- > **Must** be between sixteen and twenty four bars.
- > Must include a Da Capo al Fine of eight bars.
- > The bars **must** be numbered.
- > Expression and dynamic **must** be included and marked on the music.
- The work **must** be given a title.
- > The final composition **must** be either computer written or hand written **by the candidate**.

Viva Voce: 10 marks

- > General questions will be asked about the composition including:
 - the inspiration for this piece
 - the type and style of the music
 - the composition process used
