TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Scales and Arpeggios for Guitar Book

To be played from memory.

Scales: mm 108

Major Scales of B and F# Harmonic Minor Scale of E Melodic Minor Scale of G

Two octaves, ascending and descending.

Blues Scale of C
Position VIII, string 6

Two octaves, ascending and descending.

Major Scale of A in sixths

One octave, ascending and descending.

Arpeggios: mm J96

B and F# Major
E and G Minor
E Diminished seventh.

Two octaves, ascending and descending.

AURAL: 10 marks

- > To clap or tap a four bar melody. In either 2/4 or 6/8 time.
- To recognize whether a chord played in root position is a major seventh, dominant seventh, minor seventh or diminished seventh.
- ➤ To observe a four bar melody and then play it from memory. In 4/4 time.

**VIVA VOCE**: 10 marks

- General questions will be asked about all pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.
- To explain the construction of the blues scale.
- To explain the construction and use of the diminished seventh chord.
- To explain the tablature system.

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# **MELODY OUTLINE**: 20 marks

# **Criteria for this section:**

- The four bar introduction must include chords and a melody line.
- Both parts should be developed within the criteria given to make a complete piece.
- > Must use dual play.
- Expression and dynamics must be included and marked on the music.
- The work must be given a title.
- The final work **must** be either computer written or hand written **by the candidate**.
- A copy of the melody outline must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

## Part One: Bars 1 to 16

- ➤ The melody **may** include notes of the chord and/or passing notes.
- > Must be chorded with one chord per bar.
- The bass progression: **IIm V7 I** must be included at least once.

# Part Two: Bars 17 to 32

- A more comprehensive melody **must** be added.
- The time signature **may** be changed.
- Freedom of harmonization.

MUSICIANSHIP: 15 marks Rhythm Guitar, Book 2

#### **Transposition:**

#### Greensleeves, page 20

- Must be played from memory.
- > Must be transposed a major second lower.
- > Must be picked.
- No Capo.
- Expression and dynamics must be included.

**PIECES:** 75 marks

Melody Making, Book 2 Graded Tunes, Book 5 and 7 Rhythm Guitar, Book 2 Supplementary Tunes, Book 1

Four pieces must be performed, one piece from each section

**All** pieces **must** have an introduction and ending where none is given. Expression and dynamics **must** be included and marked on the music.

Style, improvisation and rhythmic approach are expected for this grade.

Summer Holiday Melody 2, page 28 Honesty Book 7, page 18 Take It Easy Supplementary 1, page 19

> Choose **one** piece from the list above.

#### Criteria for this section:

- > Must be picked.
- Fills **must** be added.
- > Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.

No repeats except D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

l'II Never Fall in Love Again page 8 I Dreamed a Dream page 12 Better Be Home Soon page 20

- > Choose **one** piece from the list above.
- No Capo.

#### **Criteria for this section:**

- ➤ The piece **must** be transposed into the key of Eb if the original is in a different key. Transposed chord symbols **may** be written on the music.
- ➤ **Must** be either sung by the candidate or accompanied by another instrumentalist. The candidate must count in for the accompanist unless the candidate sings.
- > Must choose own strum.
- Must include some degree of arrangement.
- Any alterations must be marked on the music by the candidate.
- Strum style optional.

Section III: 20 marks

House of the Rising Sun Rhythm 2, page 21 Unchained Melody Book 7, page 2 change to 4/4 Fernando Book 7, page 14

Choose one piece from the list above.

# Criteria for this section:

- Must use three different styles.
- Must include harmony.
- > Must be picked.
- > Transposition in part is permitted.
- > Bass runs **must** be included.
- Must have some degree of the candidate's own arrangement.
- ➤ Any alterations must be marked on the music by the candidate.

Repeats are optional.

# Section IV: 15 marks

# Book 5 Supplementary 1

Choose one piece not previously performed from the publications listed above.

# Criteria for this section:

- > The piece **must** be arranged.
- The piece **must** be notated and include **at least eight bars** of tabulation.

The tablature **must** include pitch, time values and bar lines.

An indication of which bars of the piece are being tabulated **must** be marked on the copy.

- Expression and dynamics must be included and marked on the music.
- > A copy of the arrangement must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

Repeats are optional.

All markings must be removed from pieces except expression marks, position changes and notation of arrangement. **STRICTLY NO PHOTOCOPYING**
