TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Scales and Arpeggios for Guitar Book

To be played from memory.

<u>Scales</u>: mm ↓ 108

**Any Major Scale** 

Two octaves, ascending and descending.

Blues Scale of E

Position VII, string 5.

One octave, ascending and descending.

Melodic Minor of E, in octaves

Two octaves, ascending and descending.

**Arpeggios**: mm J 96

Any Major arpeggio G Diminished seventh

AURAL: 15 marks

- To recognize whether a phrase is in a major or minor key.

  The candidate will then state whether the ending cadence is Perfect (V-I) or Interrupted (V-VI).
- To hum or sing the 1, 3, 5 degrees of an augmented or diminished chord.

The tonic will be played and the tonic note given.

The candidate will then identify the degrees by letter name.

- To observe a four bar melody and then pick it from memory.
- In 6/8 time.

**VIVA VOCE**: 10 marks

- General questions will be asked about all pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.
- To explain guitar embellishments.

# MELODY OUTLINE: 20 marks.

## Criteria for this section:

- The four bar introduction must include chords and a melody line.
- Both parts should be developed within the criteria given to make a complete piece.
- > Freedom of harmonization for parts one and two.
- Expression and dynamics must be included and marked on the music.
- The work must be given a title.
- > The final work **must** be either computer written or hand written **by the candidate**.
- ➤ A copy of the melody outline must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

# Part One: Bars 1 to 16

- > Bars 1 to 8 **must** be chorded with **one** chord per bar.
- > Bars 9 to 16 a melody note and chords **must** be continued.
- ➤ The bass progression: **IIm V7 I must** be included at least once.

## Part Two: Bars 17 to 32

- > The time signature **may** be changed.
- A more comprehensive melody **must** be added to the given chords.
- Some chord substitutions and/or chord alterations may be added.

MUSICIANSHIP: 25 marks Graded Tunes, Book 7

(Two parts).

# 1. <u>Transposition</u> 10 marks

#### **Criteria for this section:**

- To transpose an eight bar phrase.
- No capo.
- Must be played twice:

1. **Strum** the chords. 2. **Pick** the melody.

The examiner will choose from one of the following:

Key of C major, one tone lower,

OR

Key of F major, one tone higher.

# 2. Set Piece 15 marks

"Crazy" Book 7, page 22

# **Criteria for this section:**

- Must be played from memory.
- Must be transposed a major third higher.
- Dual play.
- No capo.

No repeats to be played unless D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

Cont'd: Grade Eight Guitar

PIECES: 60 marks Graded Tunes, Books 6 and 7 Supplementary Tunes, Book 2

All pieces must have a four bar introduction and ending where none is given.

Expression and dynamics must be added and noted on the music.

Style, improvisational skill and creative ability are expected for this grade.

# **Criteria for this section:**

The pieces chosen must be of contrasting style, tempo, time signature, mood and rhythm.

Repeats are optional.

Section II: 20 marks Supplementary 2

Choose three pieces from the publication listed above.

## **Criteria for this section:**

- The three pieces **must** be arranged as a medley.
- The medley **must** be in three different keys, using a four chord modulation between each key.
- > The work **must** be given a title.
- The maximum duration for the medley is **five** minutes.
- Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.
- A copy of the medley must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

All markings **must** be removed from pieces except expression marks, position changes and notation of arrangement.
