TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Comprehensive Book of Scales and Arpeggios

To be played from memory.

Scales: mm J 96

Major Scales of D, F and Bb Harmonic Minor Scale of D

Two octaves, **similar motion**, ascending and descending, hands together.

Chromatic Scale commencing on G

Two octaves, ascending and descending, separate hands.

Blues Scale of C

One octave, ascending and descending, separate hands.

mm . 84

Primary Triad Scales of D and F

One octave, ascending only.

Chords in bass position as per the scale book.

Arpeggios: mm ... 84

D and F Major and D Minor

Two octaves, ascending and descending, hands together.

G7 and F7

Two octaves, ascending and descending, separate hands.

Inversions: mm ... 84

F Major, D Minor and Bb Major consecutively

One octave, ascending only, root, first inversion, second inversion.

R.H. start position as per primary triad scale.

The complete exercise **must** be played. **Must** use a waltz auto accompaniment, one inversion per beat.

AURAL: 15 marks (Examiner to play twice on the keyboard)

To clap or tap a four bar melody. In either 3/4 or 4/4. Time values include semiquaver and those of longer duration. The candidate will be asked to identify the time signature.

- To recognize whether a chord played in root position is major, minor or dominant seventh. In the keys of D, F and Bb.
- To identify a note being one of the degrees of the major scale. The tonic will be played and the tonic note given before each degree. Identify by Tonic Sol-fa, letter name or interval number. In the keys of F and Bb.

VIVA VOCE: 10 marks

- > General questions will be asked about **all** pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.
- > To identify the tonic and dominant chords of **all** pieces performed.
- > The candidate **must** have an understanding of the instrument families of the keyboard.

SIGHT READING: 15 marks

- To play a twelve bar passage. In either 3/4 or 4/4 time.
- Auto accompaniment and fingered chords **must** be used.
- In any key up to two sharps or two flats.

PIECES: 30 marks for each piece. Keyboard Book 2

Graded Tunes, Books 1 and 3 Supplementary Tunes, Book 2

Three pieces **must** be performed, **one** piece from each section.

Voice, style and tempo registrations **must** be marked on the candidate's music.

Touch response must be used if available on the candidate's keyboard.

Expression and dynamics must be included where touch response is available, and marked on the music.

Auto accompaniment and fingered chords must be used.

- Auto accompaniment and fingered chords must be used.

Criteria for this section:

- Must include harmony.
- Must include R.H. inversions.
- Must include a change of voice.

No repeats except D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

Section II: Supplementary Tunes 2

Killing Me Softly with His Song page 5 Wild World page 7

Hey Jude page 15 (after the middle section repeat first 8 bars to the tie)

Take Me Home Country Road page 19

- Choose one piece from the publication listed above.
- > Must use an auto or manual introduction and ending.
- > Auto accompaniment and fingered chords **must** be used.

<u>Criteria for this section:</u> must include three or more of the following:

- The blues scale or part thereof **must** be included as an introduction, fill or ending.
- > Must use auto or manual fills.
- 8 va higher.
- Harmony.
- A change of voice.

No repeats except D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

Section III:

- > Choose **one** piece not previously performed from the publications listed.
- Must use an auto or manual introduction and ending.
- >> Auto accompaniment and fingered chords **must** be used.

Criteria for this section:

- > The candidate **must** include some degree of arrangement.
- Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.
- Must use either a Boogie Woogie or Blues style.

Repeats are optional.

All markings must be removed from pieces except tidy fingering, expression marks, registration settings and notation of arrangement.
