TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Comprehensive Book of Scales and Arpeggios Magic for Modern Book

To be played from memory.

Scales: mm **1**32

Harmonic Minor Scales of C# and F Melodic Minor Scales of F#, C#, C and F

Three octaves, similar motion, ascending and descending, hands together.

Must be played as quaver triplets.

Blues Scales of C and F

One octave, ascending and descending, separate hands.

mm . 120

Diatonic Chord Scales of C, G and F

One octave, ascending and descending, separate hands.

The candidate **must** state whether each chord is major, minor or diminished.

Arpeggios: mm 120

Diminished seventh in the keys of C, G and F

Two octaves, ascending and descending, separate hands.

Study: mm ... 88

Magic for Modern, Exercise No.60

Seventh chords in chromatic progression only.

AURAL: 10 marks

- > To recognize whether a chord when played in root position is major, minor, dominant seventh or diminished seventh.
- To recognize whether a major chord is in root position, or first inversion or second inversion.
- To listen to a four bar melody and then play it from memory.

The tonic note will be given.

In 3/4 time.

To demonstrate a suitable auto accompaniment for the following genres.

Ballad Rock Country and Western Latin

VIVA VOCE: 10 marks

- General questions will be asked about all pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.
- To explain the construction of all chords up to and including ninths.
- To name the intervals of the major and minor scales.
- To explain the construction of and name the diminished seventh chord in a given key.

SIGHT READING: 15 marks

- To play a passage of up to thirty two bars.
- Must include harmony.
- Must include syncopation, passing notes and fills.
- An auto accompaniment with fingered chords must be used.
- In any key up to four sharps or four flats.

MELODY OUTLINE: 20 marks

Criteria for this section:

- > The four bar introduction must include chords and a melody line.
- > Both parts should be developed within the criteria given to make a complete piece.
- > Freedom of harmonization for both parts is expected.
- A suitable auto accompaniment **must** be added to the work.
- Expression and dynamics must be included where touch response is available and marked on the music.
- Voice, style and tempo registrations must be marked on the music.
- The work must be given a title.
- The final work **must** be either computer written or hand written **by the candidate**.
- A copy of the melody outline must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations, as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

Part One: Bars 1 to 16

- The melody must include passing notes and auxiliary notes.
- One chord per bar must be added.
- The bass progression: **IIm V7 I must** be included at least once.

Part Two: Bars 17 to 32

- A more comprehensive melody must be added.
- The time signature may be changed.
- Some chord substitutions and/or chord alterations must be included.

PIECES: 60 marks

Graded Tunes Books 5, 6 and 7

Four pieces must be performed, one piece from each section.

All pieces must have an introduction and ending where none is given.

Voice, style and tempo registrations **must** be marked on the candidate's music.

Touch response **must** be used if available on the candidate's keyboard.

Expression and dynamics must be included where touch response is available and marked on the music.

Section I: 20 marks

Feelings Book 5, page 22 Song for Guy Book 6, page 12 Crazy Book 7, page 22

- Choose one piece from the publications listed above.
- Auto accompaniment and fingered chords must be used.

Criteria for this section:

- Must add the blues scale or part thereof as an introduction and/or ending.
 - The chord progression for this **must** be marked on the music.
- Some improvisation must be included.
- **May** have chord substitutions, alterations and additions.
- Expression and dynamics must be included and marked on the music.
- Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.

No repeats except D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

Section II: 20 marks

I Dreamed A Dream

- Choose one piece from the publications listed above.
- Auto accompaniment and fingered chords must be used.

Criteria for this section:

- A four chord manual introduction with a melody line **must** be added. The chord progression for this must be marked on the music.
- Some improvisation must be included.
- Must add manual and automatic fills.
- May have chord substitutions, alterations and additions.
- Expression and dynamics must be included and marked on the music.
- Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.

No repeats except D.C. or D.S. or as indicated for a specific piece.

Section III: 20 marks	Book 7
Candle in the Wind	page 10
Fernando	page 14
Better Be Home Soon	page 20

- Choose one piece from the publication listed above.
- Auto accompaniment and fingered chords must be used.

Criteria for this section:

- A manual introduction with a melody line must be added. The chord progression for this must be marked on the music.
- Must use a Latin style.
- ➤ The candidate **must** include some degree of arrangement.
- Must include a manual ending.
- **May** have chord substitutions, alterations and additions.
- Expression and dynamics must be included and marked on the music.
- Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.

Repeats are optional.

Section IV: 15 marks

Free Choice

- Choose one piece from any modern publication, after 1960.
- The piece **must** be fully notated, in any style and at an appropriate degree of difficulty for this grade.
- Must be of at least two pages duration.

Criteria for this section:

- Must be played as written.
- Must be played manually with no auto accompaniment.
- A copy of the free choice must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations as specified on the NZMSM calendar.

Repeats are optional.

All markings must be removed from pieces except tidy fingering, expression marks, registration settings and notation of arrangement.
