TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Magic on Piano, Book 1

To be played from memory.

Scales: mm ↓ 80

Major Scales of C, G and F

One octave, **similar motion**, ascending and descending, hands together.

Magic on Piano: Book 1, Exercises No.31 and 41

AURAL: 15 marks (Examiner to play twice on the keyboard)

- To clap or tap a four bar melody. In either 3/4 or 4/4 time.
 Time values include dotted minim, minim, crotchet and guaver.
- To identify a note being one of the first five degrees of the major scale. The tonic will be played and the tonic note given before each degree. Identify by Tonic Sol-fa, letter name or interval number. In the keys of C and G.

VIVA VOCE: 10 marks

General questions will be asked about all pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.

SIGHT READING: 15 marks

Option A:

- ➤ To play a four bar passage. In 4/4 time. Separate hands in the five finger position.
- > Time values include semibreve, minim and crotchet.
- In the key of C.

OR

SIGHT READING:

Option B:

- To play a six bar melody. In 3/4 time.
- > Time values include dotted minim, minim and crotchet.
- Right hand in the five finger position.
- Chord symbols will be given for the left hand.
- The chord **must** be resounded on the first beat of every bar.
- No rhythm or auto accompaniment to be used.
- In the key of C.

PIECES: 30 marks for each piece. Option A: Piano/Keyboard Course, Books 3 and 4

Option B: Beginner's Keyboard Course (red)

My Keyboard Book (green)
