Note: Choose either option A or B sight reading and pieces.

The option chosen must be continued throughout the syllabus.

TECHNICAL WORK: 20 marks

Magic on Piano, Book 2

To be played from memory.

Scales: mm ... 80

Major Scales of F and G

One octave, similar motion, ascending and descending, hands together.

End with the tonic chord, held for two beats.

Major Scale of D

One octave, ascending and descending, separate hands.

End with the tonic chord, held for two beats.

Major Scale of G

One octave, contrary motion, hands together.

Magic on Piano: Book 2, Exercises No. 3, 5 and 17

AURAL: 15 marks (Examiner to play twice on the keyboard)

To clap or tap a four bar melody. In either 3/4 or 4/4 time.

Time values include dotted minim, minim, crotchet and guaver.

To recognize whether a chord played in root position is major or minor.

In the keys of C, D and F.

VIVA VOCE: 10 marks

> General questions will be asked about **all** pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.

SIGHT READING: 15 marks

Option A:

- > To play an eight bar passage. In 4/4 time.
- Hands together.
- > Time values include semibreve, minim, crotchet and quaver.
- In the key of G.

OR

SIGHT READING:

Option B:

- To play an eight bar passage. In 4/4 time.
- Time values include semibreve, minim, crotchet, and quaver.
- Chord symbols will be given for the left hand.
- The chord **must** be resounded on the first beat of every bar.
- No rhythm or accompaniment to be used.
- In the key of G.

PIECES: 30 marks for each piece. Option A: Piano/Keyboard Course, Books 4 and 5

Musical Moments Book

Option B: Beginner's Keyboard Course (red)

My Keyboard Book (green)

Three pieces **must** be performed, **one** piece from each section.

The option chosen for the pieces **must** be the same as that of the sight reading option.

Voice, style and tempo registrations **must** be noted on the candidate's music.

Touch response **must** be used if available on the candidate's keyboard.
