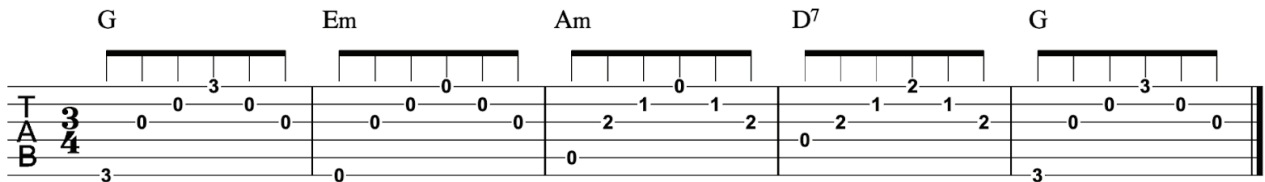

AURAL: 15 marks (Examiner to play twice on the piano)

- To clap or tap a four bar melody. In either 3/4 or 4/4 time. Time values include dotted minim, minim, crotchet and quaver.
- To recognize whether a note is raised or lowered one semitone.
- To identify a note of an arpeggio. Identify by Tonic Sol-fa or interval number.

VIVA VOCE: 10 marks

- General questions will be asked about **all** pieces performed and the technical work for this grade.

SIGHT READING: 15 marks

- To strum an eight bar passage. In 4/4 time.
- In the key of G.

- **Must** include **two** or more of the following:
Rhythm Dual play Harmony Intro Ending
- **May** have other degrees of arrangement.
- Any alterations **must** be marked on the music **by the candidate**.

All markings must be removed from pieces except expression and arrangement marks.
