One octave, **similar motion**, ascending and descending, hands together. Legato and staccato. Final note is held for one beat.

Major Scales of C, G and F

One octave, contrary motion, hands together.

Arpeggios: mm] 76

C, G and F Major

Two octaves, ascending and descending, separate hands.

Magic On Piano: mm] = 80

STUDY: 15 marks Book 2, Exercises No. 3, 4, 7 and 8

- > Arrange and perform from memory, a selection of eight bars from the exercises listed above.
- Above each bar, state the exercise and bar number being used, e.g. 4/2. No more than two consecutive bars from any one exercise should be used at a time.
- > Expression marks **must** be included and marked on the music.
- > The bars **must** be renumbered.
- > The final study **must** be either computer written or hand written **by the candidate**.
- > The candidate's name, area and level **must** be written at the top of the page.
- A copy of the study must be sent to the Area Manager 21 days prior to the commencement date of the examinations.
